



Official Visit of Prince Philippe of Belgium to Chile
Santiago, Chile

Prince Philippe of Belgium, Duke of Brabant and heir to the throne, paid an official visit to Chile together with a numerous delegation of entrepreneurs. The Prince was received by President Piñera.

This visit highlights the importance Chile and Belgium give to bi-lateral relations and strengthens them in the political and economic areas. This is the first time a Belgian delegation of this level and importance visits our country to promote the exploration of joint enterprises in key areas.
